

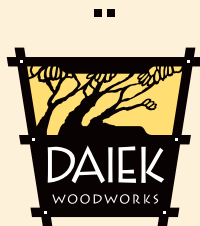

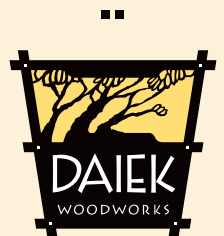

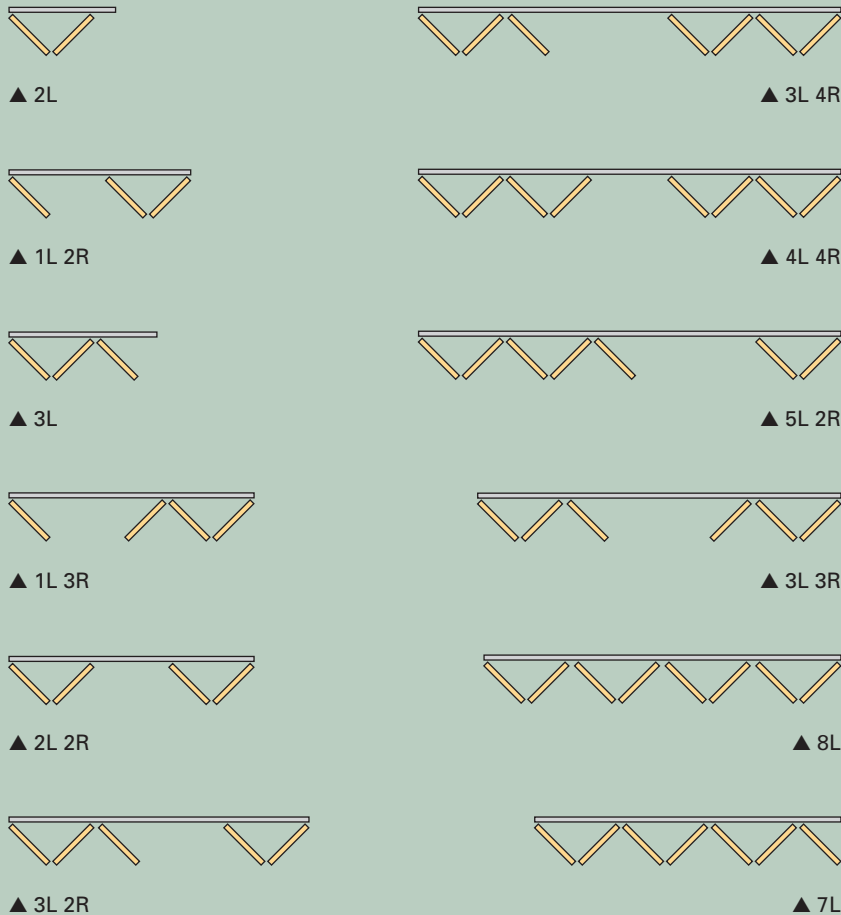

FOLDING DOOR SYSTEMS FROM DAIK WOODWORKS ALLOW LARGER OPENINGS AND MORE CONFIGURATION OPTIONS. THEY CAN ALSO BE LESS COSTLY THAN POCKETED OR SLIDING DOORS.

Above: Twelve popular folding door system ideas are shown. Almost any panel configuration is possible: inward- or outward-opening, an even or odd number of panels, up to 8 each side.

Folding door systems from Daiek Woodworks open up more design ideas. Our secure, weather-sealed, wood-framed panel system can create taller and wider openings than any other system available.

- Residential or commercial systems for patios, balconies, pool enclosures and more.
- Designed for exterior or interior use with easy operation and low maintenance.
- Solid brass, 316 series stainless steel or oil-rubbed bronze (US 10-B) hinge and carrier hardware options.
- Panels open inward or outward.
- Configurations with an odd number of panels enable users to operate one door on its own, leaving the other panels locked until needed.
- Tested for wind and water resistance with a structural wind rating of 170 mph.
- Can also be used for windows.

Folding door systems are the ideal way to create open spaces. High quality hardware and precision workmanship from Daiek Woodworks means great looks and many years of superb, trouble-free service.



Above: folding door systems can cover a maximum 48 foot-wide opening with up to 16 panels. Each panel can be up to 42-1/2" wide x 13' high. The top-hung carrier system will support up to 265 pounds per panel. Floor guides glide in an ADA-compliant flush sill or a raised profile, weather-sealed sill.
